

Green Voters Guide Available for Indiana's 2024 General Elections

Indiana — The non-partisan volunteer group "Voters for a Green Indiana" (VGI) has released its <u>Green Voters Guide</u> for the 2024 General election. The Guide is for all Hoosiers, regardless of political party, seeking to elect officials to build more sustainable and resilient communities. It includes the Indiana Governor, Congressional and US Senate races, and selected Indiana House and Senate races.

The current hurricane season exemplifies that climate change is destroying homes, lives, and livelihoods across America. Extreme weather is increasing, threatening our communities' safety, as well as our energy, food, and economic security.

<u>Indiana voters</u> overwhelmingly support climate leadership. "To stop climate change from worsening, elected officials must focus on transforming our energy from fossil fuels to renewable energy," said Hamilton County volunteer Ron Rhoads. "The Green Voters Guide provides unbiased research to inform voters about the candidates most likely to address this."
